

Connection and Use of Student Owned Device on Rossmoyne SHS Network 2014

This Policy will be available on the school website at rossmoyne.wa.edu.au and on the Student Portal course on the school Moodle site.

Use of the school network is granted to those who abide by the policies in this document. Parents are asked to discuss this policy with their child before signing it.

ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY and AGREEMENT

- Your notebook will be kept safe. It will be kept in your possession at all times while at school or secured in a locker or locked room.
- You will use the notebook as directed by your teacher. Playing games, listening to music, watching video, online chatting/messaging, accessing websites not relevant to the lesson, or any other activity on the notebook which is a distraction is not allowed on the school campus.
- You must not store anything on the notebook that you are not prepared to share with staff or your parents.
- The Department of Education strongly recommends that student owned devices are installed with up-to-date Anti-Virus protection (especially important for Windows users) and that the operating system is regularly updated.

Online Services of the Department of Education and Student Network Accounts

Online services means anything accessed using the school's wireless or wired network. Your student network account is used whenever you use the wireless network or log on to a school desktop computer.

- I will not give anyone my password.
- I will not let others use my online services account or use other people's network accounts.
- I understand that I am responsible for all activity on my network account.
- I will tell my teacher if I think someone has interfered with or is using my network account.
- If I find any information that is inappropriate or makes me feel uncomfortable I will tell a teacher about it. Examples of inappropriate content include violent, racist, sexist, or pornographic materials, or content that is offensive, disturbing or intimidating or that encourages dangerous or illegal activity.
- I will not attempt to access inappropriate material online or try to access Internet sites that have been blocked by the school or the Department of Education.
- I will not use or distribute material from another source unless authorised to do so by the copyright owner.
- I will follow the instructions of teachers and only use online services for purposes which support my learning and educational research.
- I will be courteous and use appropriate language in all Internet communications.
- I will not use the Department's online services for personal gain or illegal activity, to bully, or offend others or send inappropriate materials including software that may damage computers, data or networks.

Monitoring of this Policy

Your activity on the notebooks while at school will be monitored at any time at school using monitoring software, and this may include remotely viewing and taking control of the desktop. School staff may request access to the notebook, including access to the Internet browser history, logs, caches and files and programs stored on the notebook. I understand that the school and the Department of Education may monitor any information sent or received using the school network and can trace activity to the network accounts of specific users.

You will not alter any configuration on the computer that may prevent monitoring of your desktop by staff while at school.

I understand that

- I will be held responsible for my actions while using online services and for any breaches caused by allowing any other person to use my online services account;
- the misuse of online services may result in the withdrawal of access to services and other consequences dictated in the Schools policy; and
- I may be held legally liable for offences committed using online services.

I agree to abide by the Acceptable Use Policy.
